ADJUDICATORS' BIOGRAPHIES

Marion Miller, Piano, began teaching piano at 12 and entered the University of Western Ontario at 16, graduating with a master's degree in music performance and the President's Gold Medal for academic excellence. She later studied with musical legends Ozan Marsh at Chautauqua, Cecile Genhart in Zurich and Marcel Ciampi in Paris. Her career has ranged from symphony orchestras and swing bands to musical theatre and lounge performances and she has taught in university, conservatory and festival settings. Her private students span the gamut from young beginners to other piano teachers. She has adjudicated music festivals from coast to coast.

Lesley Andrew, Vocals, has made soloist appearances with the Vancouver, Kingston, Hamilton, Guelph and Georgian Bay Symphony Orchestras, Wellington Winds, Weston Silver Band, Hart House Orchestra, Canadian Male Orpheus Choir, Kitchener-Waterloo Chamber Orchestra, Brott Summer Music Festival, Drayton Festival, Shenandoah Bach Festival (VA, USA), KW Symphony and with many of Canada's finest choral organizations. 'Celebrating Rodgers,' recorded live at the Glenn Gould Studio, featuring Ms. Andrew and bass baritone Daniel Lichti, has been heard on CBC Radio. Known for her extraordinary vocal range and versatility in many genres of music, Ms. Andrew often 'switches hats', performing as the soprano soloist for one engagement and as the alto soloist for the next – from opera to show tunes, oratorio to jazz. Immediately following her graduation from Wilfrid Laurier University (Honours Bachelor of Music, Performance Voice, second study Fine Arts, post graduate Opera Diploma), Ms. Andrew began an extended tenure with the Stratford Festival, performing in productions including The Mikado, The Pirates of Penzance, Twelfth Night, Cyrano De Bergerac, Alice Through the Looking Glass, The Music Man and Patience. Other theatrical performances include Menotti's 'The Telephone' and Hopkin's 'Three's Company' at the Guelph Spring Festival (featuring and directed by Ms. Andrew.) Ms. Andrew has completed a number of major concert and recital tours, including Europe (1989/1990 – Canadian Concert & Jazz Band), the 1999 World Tour aboard the QE II, two USA tours (California/Arizona/Florida/Texas) and a Canadian tour with The Lesley Andrew Trio (Vancouver/Manitoba/Ontario). January 2005 marked Ms. Andrew's first concert tour of Argentina.

A recipient of many awards, among them the Canadian Opera Company Scholarship (COC-Peel Guild) and the Maureen Forrester Guthrie Award (The Stratford Festival), Ms. Andrew now adjudicates and conducts masterclasses at festivals, universities and schools of music & drama around the world (voice, choral music and speech arts classes.) Having recently moved from Stratford, Ontario, (where she was twice nominated as 'Citizen of the Year), Ms. Andrew now runs her thriving voice and drama studio - Dream in Progress Productions - in London, where she now resides. As a director, Ms. Andrew is much in demand in the genres of musical theatre and opera. An accomplished textile artist, Ms. Andrew's works have been featured in magazines and hang in homes and businesses across North America.

Ms. Andrew has made special guest television appearances on The Tonight Show, Oprah Winfrey, To Tell the Truth, Donny & Marie, The Comedy Network, YTV, Regis & Kathy Lee and many more. A popular motivational speaker, Ms. Andrew is engaged across Canada by Educators, Universities, Corporations, Service Clubs and Student Organizations.

Recent professional activities include teaching and directing appointments at Wilfrid Laurier University and the Universities of Windsor and Western Ontario. The Lesley Andrew Trio performed at London's wonderful Aeolian Hall. Having recently completed a Masters of Music; Performance and Literature (on full scholarship) from the University of Western Ontario, Ms. Andrew continues to take bookings as a director, soloist, adjudicator, pedagogue (at the post secondary level) and motivational speaker well, while maintaining a full teaching schedule in her private studio.

Jeffery L. Stokes, , studied double bass (with Oscar Zimmerman, Principal Double Bass in Toscanini's NBC Orchestra) and musicology at the Eastman School of Music of the University of Rochester. He subsequently took a PhD degree in musicology at the State University of New York in Buffalo. First appointed to the Faculty of Music of The University of Western Ontario in 1970, he became Director of Graduate Studies in Music in 1984 and served as Dean from 1986 to 2000. Current duties include both studio teaching, undergraduate lectures in music history, graduate seminars for performers and producing the Faculty's flagship 12:30 Fridays concert series.

He continues to perform and record as a chamber player and narrator-actor, and with orchestras throughout Ontario; and to lecture, give clinics, and adjudicate throughout Canada and recently in Hong Kong. He has served as a consultant to both the Canada Council and the Ontario Arts Council, and as a judge for the Juno Awards.

Doug Shippey, earned his Honours Bachelors of Music and his Master of Music in Music Education from the University of Western Ontario, and has spent a lifetime steeped in a spectrum of musical genres.

As the former Head of Music at Huron Park Secondary School (Woodstock, Ontario), Woodstock Collegiate Institute, and Ingersoll District Collegiate, Doug was a leader in the field of music education. He performed in the former London Symphony Orchestra, performed in recording studios, and practiced his craft as a violinist and trombonist in several orchestras, concert bands, and jazz ensembles in Southwestern Ontario. Doug works as an arranger, a clinician, a conductor, and is the Musical Director of the Woodstock Choralaires. As the Director of the Choralaires, Doug brings forth a musical energy that inspires the members of the choir and an artistic drive that brings high praises to each Choralaire performance.

Doug continues to be a champion for the Arts and has said, "The Arts defines our culture. Without the arts, we would live in a society that lacks identity and direction. The Arts measures our identity and provides a requisite dimension to form our vision as a people."

Doug earned his Honours Bachelors of Music and his Master of Music in Music Education from the University of Western Ontario, and has spent a lifetime steeped in a spectrum of musical genres.
